THE BASICS

What play did you see?

Explain where and when you saw the play.

STORY/PLOT (Did they really watch it?)

Briefly explain the inciting event/incident of the story.

Describe what happened during the climax of the story?

List one of the play's main characters and describe his/her personality.

ACTING QUESTIONS

Choose one actor: Describe what they did well and how they could improve.

Choose another actor: Describe what they did well and how they could improve.

TECHNICAL QUESTION

Describe how a technical element (lights, sound, costumes, set, props, etc.) was used to help tell the story.

PERSONAL CONNECTION

Describe a theme presented in the production? (A theme is a lesson or moral)

Do you agree with the theme? Explain why or why not.

Describe your favorite moment in this production. Why was it your favorite? (Please be specific--this can include a song, acting choice, theme addressed, etc.)

Describe your least favorite moment in this production. Why was it not your favorite? (Please be specific-this can include a song, acting choice, theme addressed, etc.)

Do you think others would benefit from seeing this production? Why?

How did the audience respond to the production?
